<b><u>Purpose</u></b> The money in the fund is used to support the California State Law Library.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> California State Library/Org 6120		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Sixty-five dollars of each fee collected in a civil case by the clerk of each court of appeal pursuant to Government Code section 68926 (a).		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in the fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> -Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<b><u>Comments/ Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 193, Statutes of 2009 extended repeal date until January 1, 2015. Chapter 34, Statutes of 2014 extended the repeal date until January 1, 2020, unless another statute extends that date. November 2021: Chapter 53, Statutes of 2019 (SB 77), Government Code section 68926.3 (c) extended the repeal date until January 1, 2025, unless another statute extends or repeals that date.
