Purpose

This fund is used to deposit various fees collected from radioactive materials and persons possessing and operating sources of ionizing radiation. The fund will be used for the operating and administrative expenses of the program.

Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Public Health/Org Code 4265

Major Sources of Revenue

Fees charged for licensing of radioactive materials and for persons possessing and operating sources of ionizing radiation. All interest earned by the Radiation Control Fund shall be deposited in the Radiation Control Fund.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

Moneys in this fund are available upon appropriation by the Legislature.

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.

Comments/Historical Information

Chapter 670, Statutes of 1992 originally created the Radiation Control Fund in Health and Safety Code section 25804.

Chapter 415, Statutes of 1995 repealed the Health and Safety Code section 25804 moved the fund to Health and Safety Code section 114980.

Original Administrative Organization Code 4260 was changed to 4265 due to the Department of Health Services splitting into two departments effective July 2007 according to Chapter 241, Statutes of 2007 (SB162).
