<u>Purpose</u> A depository for all funds appropriated by the Legislature for the purpose of paying, on behalf of foster family homes and small family homes, claims ad litem resulting from occurrences peculiar to the foster-care relationship and the provision of foster-care services.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Social Services/Org 5180		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> An appropriation from the General Fund. It is the intent of the Legislature to maintain the fund established pursuant to Section 1527.1 at an adequate level to meet anticipated liabilities pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 1527.8.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Paying claims ad litem, on behalf of foster family homes and small family homes, resulting from occurrences peculiar to the foster-care relationship and the provision of foster-care services.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Consists of all money appropriated by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded - The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.
