<u>Purpose</u> Money in the fund will be used to fund program personnel salary costs, contracts with technically qualified persons, and other program costs or costs directly supporting program staff. Department of Social Services may be used up to five percent of the fees collected for overhead costs.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Social Services/5180		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees imposed on continuing care providers, including an application fee and an annual fee.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 901 Statutes of 1987 originally established the Life Care Provider Fee Fund. August 2000: The legal title of this fund was changed to the Continuing Care Provider Fee Fund by Chapter 875 of the Statutes of 1990, which repealed Section 1793 of the Health and Safety Code and added Section 1778. July 2023: The legal title of this fund was changed from Continuing Care Provider Fee Fund to CCRC Oversight Fund in accordance with Chapter 538, Statutes of 2022 (SB 707), Health and Safety Code section 1778 (a).
