Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

The money is available when appropriated by the Legislature.

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to provide direct services or products to the payers.

Comments/Historical Information

Chapter 323, Statutes of 1983 originally created this fund under the Health and Safety Code section 13142.5.

Chapter 1574, Statutes of 1984 changed fund title to California Fire and Arson Training Fund from California Fire Service Training and Education System Fund.

Chapter 653, Statutes of 1988 renumbered this fund to the Health and Safety Code section 13159.10.
