<b><u>Purpose</u></b> The Registry of International Student Exchange Visitor Placement Organizations Fund was created to support the administrative costs of the Attorney General to establish registration fees, set renewal fees, adjust annual fees, and collect fees from organizations which arrange the placement of international student exchange visitors in U.S. schools, K-12.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Justice/Org 0820		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Registration or renewal fees.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> -Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.
