Purpose

Funds are used to pay expenses of the Board of Pilot Commissioners and its officers for the licensure and regulation of bar pilots in accordance with Harbors and Navigation Code section 1100 through 1203.

Administering Agency/Organization Code

Board of Pilot Commissioners for the Bays of San Francisco, San Pablo, and Suisun./Org 2670

Major Revenue Source

A percentage of pilotage fees collected by licensed pilots pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code section 1190.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, the moneys deposited in the fund are appropriated without regard to fiscal years pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code section 1159 (b).

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.
