Purpose

To support the general operations of the State Athletic Commission (Commission) that regulates boxing, wrestling, and martial arts competitions in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 18800 through 18828.

Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Consumer Affairs - Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111

Major Revenue Source

A variety of license application and renewal fees; and fees based on a fraction of each admission ticket to state sanctioned events.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

Business and Professions Code section 18801 states that the salaries and expenses of the Commission and employees shall be paid from funds appropriated.

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.

Comments/Historical Information

Chapter 150, Statutes of 1994 abolished this fund effective July 1, 1994.

Chapter 227, Statutes of 2004 re-created this fund and changed the administering agency from Department of Consumer Affairs-Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to Department of Consumer Affairs – Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111.

Chapter 465, Statutes of 2006 re-established the Commission under the Department of Consumer Affairs-Regulatory Boards/Org 1110.

Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization.
