<u>Legal Title</u> Solid Waste Disposal Site Cleanup Trust Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 655, Statutes of 1993 (AB 2136) Public Resources Code sections 48020-48028

<u>Purpose</u> The Board is required to initiate a program on January 1, 1994, for the cleanup of solid waste disposal sites and solid waste at co disposal sites, as defined, where the responsible party either cannot be identified or is unable or unwilling to pay for timely remediation, and where cleanup is needed to protect public health and safety and the environment. A \$5,000,000 maximum can be expended during a fiscal year, beginning in the 1994-95 year.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery/Org 3970		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Appropriated funds from the Integrated Waste Management Account, interest earned from the money in the trust fund, and cost recoveries from responsible parties for solid waste disposal loan repayments.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> If Public Resources Code section 48027 that created this fund is repealed, the trust fund shall be dissolved and all money shall be distributed to solid waste landfill operators who have paid into the trust fund during the effective life of the trust fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Public Resources Code section 48027 provides that the money in the trust fund is continuously appropriated to the Board without regard to fiscal years.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are transferred from another excluded fund, 0387 Integrated Waste Management Fund, and the purpose or use remains the same.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 21, Statutes of 2009 (SB 63) Section 9 changed Administering Org from the California Integrated Waste Management Board/Org 3910 to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery/Org 3500 per Public Resources Code section 40401(a)(1). Pursuant to the Governor’s Reorganization Plan 2, the Administering Agency’s Organization Code changed from Org 3500 to Org 3970, effective July 1, 2013.
