<u>Legal Title</u> Transcript Reimbursement Fund		
<u>Legal Citation/Authority</u> Chapter 1350, Statutes of 1980 Business and Professions Code section 8030.2 (d)		
<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds		<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds
<u>Purpose</u> To provide shorthand reporting services to low-income litigants in civil cases who are unable to otherwise afford those services.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Consumer Affairs – Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfers from the Court Reporters’ Fund (Fund 0771) and refunds from applicants who were reimbursed in a court ordered judgment or settlement pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 8030 through 8031.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 8030.2 (g) and notwithstanding Government Code section 16346, all unencumbered funds remaining in the Transcript Reimbursement Fund as of January 1, 2017, shall be transferred to Fund 0771.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, moneys in the Transcript Reimbursement Fund are continuously appropriated for the purposes of this chapter.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes; however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use and purposes for which they are used.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 1350, Statutes of 1980 created this fund. Chapter 895, Statutes of 1996 continued the existence of this fund. Chapter 518, Statutes of 2010 continued the existence of this fund. The Court Reporters Board administers this fund within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization.
