To offset cost incurred by the department pursuant to the Gambling Control Act.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

This fund is available upon appropriation by the Legislature.

State Appropriations Limit

Always Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from fines and penalties.

Comments/Historical Information

This fund was established per Business & Professions Code section 19940(a), Chapter 867, Statutes of 1997. This was amended and renumbered to Business & Professions Code section 19950(a), Chapter 738, Statutes of 2002 (AB 2431).
