<u>Purpose</u> The Private Investigator Fund provides appropriations for the regulation and licensing of private investigators.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Consumer Affairs/1111		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Application fees, license fees and penalties.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> In accordance with Business and Professions Code section 7571, all revenue received pursuant to the Private Investigator Act shall be credited to the Private Security Services Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> August 2012: Bureau of Collection and Investigative Services administers this fund within the Department. August 2012: Similar Business and Professions Code section 7571 was added by Chapter 1543, Statutes of 1947, and then repealed by Chapter 1190, Statutes of 1980. It was then re-added by Chapter 1196, Statutes of 1983, and then repealed by Chapter 1285, Statutes of 1994. April 2026: Chapter 377, Statutes of 2019 (SB 609), Business and Professions Code section 7571, repealed related to the Private Investigator Fund. This fund is abolished effective January 1, 2020.
