<b><u>Legal Title</u></b> Court Reporters Fund		
<b><u>Legal Citation/Authority</u></b> Chapter 26, Statutes of 1994 (AB 1807) Business and Professions Code section 8030

<b><u>Purpose</u></b> A depository for all fees collected by the Court Reporters Board (Board) which is used for two purposes: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To support the Board's certification and regulation of court reporters in accordance Business and Professions Code section 8000 through 8047, and</li> <li>2. For transfers to the Transcripts Reimbursement Fund (Fund 0410) that provides shorthand reporting services to low-income litigants in civil cases who are unable to otherwise afford those services.</li> </ol>		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Department of Consumer Affairs – Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Certification fees and fines provided in Business and Professions Code section 8031.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Chapter 191, Statutes of 1953 added this fund. Chapter 26, Statutes of 1994 changed the legal title of this fund from Shorthand Reporters' Fund to Court Reporters Fund. The Board administers this fund within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization.
