<u>Purpose</u> To provide moneys for the licensure and regulation of vocational nursing in accordance Business and Professions Code section 2840 through 2858.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Consumer Affairs – Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> License fees and fines in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 2892 through 2895.5.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 1689, Statutes of 1951 created the Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners and the Vocational Nurse Examiners Fund. Chapter 759, Statutes of 1997 amended the title from the Vocational Nurse Examiners Fund to the Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians Fund. The Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians administer this fund within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization.
