<u>Purpose</u> Administrative and operating costs of the Department of Managed Care.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Managed Health Care/Org 4150		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfer of existing managed care related money from the State Corporation Fund (0067), fees, assessments, reimbursements or other monies charged and collected by the Department of Managed Care.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded -Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred could become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the managed care industry.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> The responsibilities of this fund were originally incorporated in the State Corporation Fund and were transferred to the Department of Managed Care established by Chapter 525 Statutes of 1999. Chapter 552, Statutes of 2011 moved the Dept of Managed Health Care under the Health and Human Services Agency which requires a new Org code.
