Purpose

Establish and maintain laboratory infrastructure, DNA sample storage, DNA analysis, and labor costs for cases of missing persons and identified remains. Up to 5% of the fees collected may be used for administration costs.

Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Justice/Org 0820

Major Revenue Source

Fee increase of \$2 for death certificates.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

No appropriation authority was noted in the legislation. The Budget Act or legislation may establish later appropriation.

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.

Comments/Historical Information

Per Chapter 822 Statutes of 2000 created this fund will remain in effect only until January 1, 2006, unless that date is repealed or extended by a later enacted statute.

Chapter 471, Statutes of 2005 changed the repeal date to January 1, 2010.

Chapter 228, Statutes of 2009 deleted the repeal date.
