<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds	<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental Cost Fund/Other Governmental Cost Funds	
<u>Purpose</u> This fund was created to promote access to trauma care by ensuring the availability of services through EMS emergency – designated trauma centers.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Emergency Medical Service Authority/Org Code 4120		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Initial transfer of \$25 million from the General Fund.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Moneys in this fund are continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal year.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – The major revenue source is transferred from another fund which has already been counted in an included fund, the General Fund (0001), and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 171, Statutes of 2001 created this fund.
