<u>Purpose</u> To provide moneys to the Naturopathic Medicine Committee (Committee) for the licensure and regulation of naturopathic doctors in accordance Business and Professions Code section 3610 through 3686.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Consumer Affairs – Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees assessed by the Committee pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 3680.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 485, Statutes of 2003 created this fund. Chapter 18, Statutes of 2009 changed the administering agency from the Department of Consumer Affairs Bureaus, Programs, Divisions/Org 1111 to the Department of Consumer Affairs Regulatory Boards/Org 1110. The Committee administers this fund under the jurisdiction of the Osteopathic Medical Board of California within the Department of Consumer Affairs. Effective October 2015, administering agency change from the Department of Consumer Affairs – Regulatory Boards/Org 1110 to the current organization.
