<u>Purpose</u> To deposit monies recovered from the review of Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point plans and variances, and to implement the provisions of the California Retail Food Code.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Public Health/4265		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Any person requesting the department to undertake any activity pursuant to Sections 114056, 114417, and 114419.3 shall pay the department's costs incurred in undertaking the activity.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> In accordance with Health and Safety Code section 113718, all moneys deposited in the Retail Food Safety and Defense Fund shall be transferred to the Food Safety Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> September 2007: Chapter 241, Statutes of 2006 (SB162), Administering Agency changed from Department of Health Services/4260 to Department of Public Health/4265 due to the Department of Health Services splitting into two departments effective July 2007. November 2023: Chapter 23, Statutes of 2012 (AB 1467), Health and Safety Code section 113718 repealed related to Retail Food Safety and Defense Fund. This fund is abolished with the effective date of June 27, 2012.
