<u>Purpose</u> The development and support of a training curriculum specific to lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender domestic abuse support service providers who serve that community in regard to domestic violence, and to provide brochures specific to lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender domestic abuse.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Office of Emergency Services/Org 0690		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> A fee of twenty-three dollars to be charged in addition to the existing fees established by regulation to persons filing domestic partner registrations.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Fund established in Chapter 856, Statutes of 2006 (AB 2051). Per Chapter 372, Statutes of 2008, the Office of Emergency Services and the Office of Homeland Security are merged to form the California Emergency Management Agency. February 2022: Updated the Administering Agency description from California Emergency Management Agency to Office of Emergency Services.
