<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>GAAP Basis</u> Governmental/Special Revenue Funds		<u>Fund Classification</u> <u>Legal Basis</u> Governmental/Other Governmental Cost Funds
<u>Purpose</u> All funds shall be used exclusively to enhance federal financial participation for hospital services under the Medi-Cal program, to provide additional reimbursement to, and to support quality improvement efforts of, hospitals, and to minimize uncompensated care provided by hospitals to uninsured patients, in priority order specified in Welfare and Institutions Code section 14167.35 (c).		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Fees paid by hospitals pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14168.32 plus any interest and dividends earned in the fund.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> Chapter 627, Statutes of 2009 established this fund. Chapter 286, Statutes of 2011 repeals this fund as of January 1, 2015 pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14167.35 (k). Chapter 657, Statutes of 2013 extended the repeal date to January 1, 2018.
