#### **Purpose**

The moneys in the fund shall be made available to the department to be used as follows:

- a) Administrative costs of the department in administering this program.
- b) Twenty percent of the fund remaining after payment of administrative costs shall be used to offset the state portion of the Medi-Cal reimbursement rate for emergency medical air transportation services.
- Eighty percent of the fund remaining after payment of the administrative costs shall be used to augment emergency medical air transportation reimbursement payments made through the Medi-Cal program.

### Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Health Care Services/Org 4260

#### **Major Revenue Source**

Penalty of four dollars (\$4) shall be imposed upon every conviction for a violation of the Vehicle Code or a local ordinance adopted pursuant to the Vehicle Code, except parking offenses subject to Article 3 (commencing with Section 40200) of Chapter 1 of Division 17 of the Vehicle Code.

#### **Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)**

Pursuant to Government Code section 76000.10 (f) moneys remaining unexpended and unencumbered in this fund shall be transferred to the General Fund.

#### **Appropriation Authority**

Upon appropriation by the Legislature.

## **State Appropriations Limit**

**Always Excluded** – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from penalties.

### **Comments/Historical Information**

Chapter 718, Statutes of 2017 changed the legal title from the Emergency Medical Air Transportation Act Fund to its current title and extended the repeal date to January 1, 2022.
