| <u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfer of proceeds of the quality assurance fee from the Hospital Quality Assurance Revenue Fund and transfers from governmental entities in accordance with Welfare and Institutions Code section 14169.7.5(b). | | |
| <u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund. | | |
| <u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature. | | |
| <u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are transferred from another excluded fund and the purpose or use remains the same. | | |
