<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To receive Mobile Telephony Service (MTS) surcharges for transfer to the State Emergency Telephone Number Account (Fund 0022) in the General Fund.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> Governor's Office of Emergency Services/0690		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Surcharges, interest, penalties, and other amounts collected		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> All money deposited shall be transferred to the State Emergency Telephone Number Account in the General Fund pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code section 42023 (b) (1).		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – The major revenue source has a logical, direct relationship between the use or purposes and the payers from whom it was collected. Therefore, revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> Revenue and Taxation Code section 42024 repeals this fund as of January 1, 2020. October 2015: Administering agency changed from Public Utilities Commission/8660 to the current organization. September 2023: Chapter 885, Statutes of 2014 (AB 1717), Revenue and Taxation Code section 42024 repealed related to Prepaid MTS 911 Account. This account is abolished effective January 1, 2020.
