<u>Purpose</u> To support mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, and diversion programs for people in the criminal justice system with an emphasis on the recidivism reduction program in accordance with Penal Code section 6046 through 6046.3.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Board of State and Community Corrections/Org 5227		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Transfers from the Safe Neighborhoods and Schools Fund (Fund 3286) and from any other federal, state, or local grant, or from any private donation or grant pursuant to Penal Code section 6046.2 (b).		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal year.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund have already been counted in or will be counted in an excluded fund, the Safe Neighborhood and Schools Fund (3286), and should not be double counted.
