#### **Purpose**

To implement, operate and enforce the ammunition authorization program in accordance with Penal Code sections 30370 through 30395.

#### Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Justice/0820

### **Major Revenue Source**

A \$25 million loan from the General Fund pursuant to Penal Code section 30371 (a) and ammunition purchase authorization fees.

# **Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)**

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

## **Appropriation Authority**

Notwithstanding Government Code section 13340, funds are continuously appropriated.

#### **State Appropriations Limit**

**Excluded** – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes; however, when transferred, they may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.

#### **Comments/Historical Information**

Proposition 63 – The Safety for All Act of 2016 – was approved by voters on November 8, 2016.

October 2018: Establishing Authority changed from Prop 63, Penal Code section 30370 (h).

May 2023: Updated the GAAP Basis classification from General Fund to Special Revenue Funds.
