<b><u>Purpose</u></b> To deposit rebates from drug manufacturers to fund the nonfederal share of the health care services for children, adults, seniors, and persons with disabilities enrolled in the Medi-Cal Program.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Business Unit Code</u></b> State Department of Health Care Services/4260		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Rebates from drug manufacturers.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal year.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.
