Major Revenue Source

Transfers from the Behavioral Health Services Fund.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

Continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal years.

State Appropriations Limit

Always Excluded – Revenues in this fund have already been counted in an included fund, the Behavioral Health Services Fund (3085), and should not be double counted.

Comments/Historical Information

August 2019: This fund is a subaccount in the Mental Health Services Fund. The Mental Health Services Fund was created by an initiative measure enacted by voters as Proposition 63 at the November 2004 general election. Aggregate transfers from the Mental Health Services Fund to the Supportive Housing Program Subaccount is limited to a maximum of \$140,000,000 per year.
