<u>Purpose</u> The fund will be used to separately track and monitor revenues and expenditures related to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) activities performed by the Department of Fish and Wildlife, as required by Fish and Game Code section 711.44.		
<u>Administering Agency/Business Unit Code</u> Department of Fish and Wildlife/3600		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> CEQA filing fees		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> January 2020: This fund was administratively established to enable the Department of Fish and Wildlife implement the California State Auditor’s audit recommendation in Report 2018-119, for the Department to comply with state law that require the use of CEQA fees for CEQA purposes only. CEQA filing fees originally received into the Fish and Game Preservation Fund (Fund 0200), will going forward be received into this fund.
