<b><u>Purpose</u></b> A depository for registration fees collected from data brokers to be used for the purpose of offsetting the costs of establishing and maintaining an informational internet website for public access of the information provided by data brokers.		
<b><u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u></b> California Privacy Protection Agency/1703		
<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> Registration fees collected from data brokers.		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.		
<b><u>Comments/Historical Information</u></b> January 2024: Chapter 709, Statutes of 2023 (SB 362), Civil Code section 1798.99.81, changed the administering agency from Department of Justice/0820 to California Privacy Protection Agency/1703.
