<u>Purpose</u> Money in the fund shall be used to pay all costs arising from the implementation of Health and Safety Code, Division 109 and rendering services to state entities as required, including, but not limited to, employment and compensation of necessary personnel and expenses, such as operating and other expenses of the Center for Data Insights and Innovation, and costs associated with technical assistance, and to establish reserve.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Health and Human Services Agency/0530		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> • Moneys appropriated and made available by the Legislature for the purposes of Division 109 of Health and Safety Code. • Revenues received from the services provided for in Division 109 of Health and Safety Code. • Moneys available to the Center for Data Insights and Innovation from any other source, including return on investments. • Fee-for-service payments from non-state entities.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Excluded - Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues are used to regulate the activities engaged in by the payers.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> In accordance with Health and Safety Code section 130207 (b), this fund is the successor fund to the Office of Health Information Integrity Trust Fund. Unexpended or unencumbered moneys in the fund at the end of the fiscal year may be carried forward to the next succeeding fiscal year (Health and Safety Code section 130207 (a)) All interest earned on moneys deposited in the fund shall be retained in the fund and used for purposes consistent with Division 109 of Health and Safety Code (Health and Safety Code section 130207 (c)). The Center for Data Insights and Innovation may apply to United States Secretary of Health and Human Services for federal grants, and to the extent permitted by federal law, may seek federal financial participation for assisting Medi-Cal program beneficiaries (Health and Safety Code section 130207 (g)).
