<u>Purpose</u> Money in the fund will be used to provide grants under the Small and Rural Hospital Relief Program to small, rural, and critical access hospitals that meet criteria specified in Health and Safety Code section 130078 (a), for the purpose of funding seismic safety compliance.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Access and Information /4140		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Moneys allocated from California Electronic Cigarette Excise Tax Fund pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code section 31005 (b) (6).		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, in the absence of language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment, shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> In accordance with Health and Safety Code section 130077 (b), all moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated without regard to fiscal year.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Always Excluded –The major revenue source is transferred from an Included Fund, Electronic Cigarette Excise Tax Fund (3366), which has already been counted and should not be double counted.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> In accordance with Health and Safety Code section 130078 (b), a grant provided by the department pursuant to the Small and Rural Hospital Relief Program may be used only for funding seismic safety compliance.
