<b><u>Purpose</u></b> The fund will receive transfers from the Settlement Deposits Fund money deposited from the settlement of People v. McKinsey & Company, Inc. and funds allocated to the state for state opioid remediation from the 2022 settlements with Johnson & Johnson, Janssen Pharmaceuticals, McKesson, Cardinal Health, and AmerisourceBergen. Money in the fund will be used for opioid remediation in accordance with the terms of the judgement or settlement from which the funds were received.

<b><u>Major Revenue Source</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transfers of opioid settlement funds from the Litigation Deposits Fund.</li> <li>• Future Opioid settlements or judgements funds not deposited in the Litigation Deposits Fund.</li> </ul>		
<b><u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u></b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b><u>Appropriation Authority</u></b> Upon appropriation by the Legislature.		
<b><u>State Appropriations Limit</u></b> <b>Always Excluded</b> – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes and even after transfer, will never become proceeds of taxes because the major revenue source is derived from a Trust and Agency Fund (Non-Federal).
