<u>Purpose</u> Money in the Fund shall be expended as follows: 40 percent to the Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Wildlife Conservation Board, the State Coastal Conservancy, the California Coastal Commission, the Ocean Protection Council, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Natural Resources Agency, and the California Environmental Protection Agency to monitor and reduce the environmental impacts of plastics on terrestrial, aquatic, and marine life and human health, including to restore, recover, and protect the natural environment. 60 percent to the Strategic Growth Council, the California Environmental Protection Agency, the Natural Resources Agency, and the Department of Justice to monitor and reduce the historical and current environmental justice and public health impacts of plastics, including to mitigate the historical and current impact of plastics on disadvantaged or low-income communities or rural areas.		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Resources Recycling and Recovery/3970		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> - Surcharges assessed on Producer Responsibility Organizations - Interests, penalties and other amounts collected and paid pursuant Public Resources Code section 42064.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Included – Revenues in this fund are proceeds of taxes, therefore, the fund is classified as included.
