Purpose

Money in the fund will be used by the Department of Fish and Wildlife to pay for all or a portion of its costs related to the following:

- Mitigation credit agreement with a person or entity
- Proposed strategy or proposed assessment by a public agency or federally recognized tribe

Administering Agency/Organization Code

Department of Fish and Wildlife/3600

Major Revenue Source

In accordance with Fish and Game Code section 1857 (b), the department shall collect fees or other compensation from a person or an entity that proposes to enter into a mitigation credit agreement, and from a public agency or federally recognized tribe that proposes a regional conservation investment strategy or a regional conservation assessment.

Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)

Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.

Appropriation Authority

Upon appropriation by the Legislature

State Appropriations Limit

Excluded – Revenues in this fund are not proceeds of taxes, however, when transferred, may become proceeds of taxes. These revenues have a logical, direct relationship with the use or purposes for which they are used.
