<u>Purpose</u> Managed Care Enrollment Fund is created to replace the Health Care Services Special Fund. Managed care organization provider tax revenue will be deposited into this fund. Money deposited into this fund is available upon appropriation by the legislature to fund the following subcomponents to support the Medi-Cal program: 1. Nonfederal share of increased capitation payments to Medi-Cal managed care plans 2. Nonfederal share of Medi-Cal managed care rates for health care services 3. Transfers to the Medi-Cal Provider Payment Reserve Fund		
<u>Administering Agency/Organization Code</u> Department of Health Care Services/4260		
<u>Major Revenue Source</u> Proceeds received from imposed managed care organization provider taxes.		
<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Upon appropriation by the Legislature		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Included - Revenues in fund are proceeds of taxes, therefore, this fund is classified as included.
