<u>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</u> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<u>Appropriation Authority</u> Continuously appropriated.		
<u>State Appropriations Limit</u> Included - Revenues in fund are proceeds of taxes, therefore, this fund is classified as included.		
<u>Comments/Historical Information</u> January 2025: Proposition 35 was approved in the November 5, 2024, election and operative on January 1, 2025, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.135. The Health Care Oversight & Accountability Subfund (Fund 3443) and the Improving Access to Health Care Subfund (Fund 3444) are created within the fund.
