<b>Purpose</b> Moneys in the fund will be used to cover the following pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.108 (b). A) Cover the appropriations made pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.108.3 for the 2025 and 2026 calendar years only. B) 2025 and subsequent calendar years, the nonfederal share of increased capitation payments to Medi-Cal managed care plans to cover projected tax obligation in accordance with Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.84 or Article 6 (commencing with Section 14199.123), as applicable. C) Reimbursement of the Controller for its responsibilities under the Protect Access to Health Care Act of 2024. D) Department of Health Care Services' administrative costs. E) Repayment of any refunds, as applicable. F) Costs incurred pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.133.		
<b>Administering Agency/Organization Code</b> Department of Health Care Services/4260		
<b>Major Revenue Source</b> Annual transfers from the Protect Access to Health Care Fund.		
<b>Disposition of Fund (upon abolishment)</b> Pursuant to Government Code section 16346, absent language that identifies a successor fund, any balance remaining in this fund upon abolishment shall be transferred to the General Fund.		
<b>Appropriation Authority</b> Continuously appropriated.		
<b>State Appropriations Limit</b> <b>Always Excluded</b> —Revenues in this fund are transferred from an Included fund, the Protect Access to Health Care Fund (3442), which have already been counted and should not be double counted.		
<b>Comments/Historical Information</b> January 2025: Proposition 35 was approved in the November 5, 2024, election and operative on January 1, 2025, pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 14199.135. This subfund is created within the Protect Access to Health Care Fund (Fund 3442), and any unencumbered moneys remaining in the subfund at the end of a calendar year shall be transferred to the Improving Access to Health Care Subfund.
